

## STUDENTS CURRENTLY ENROLLED AT THE KING'S ACADEMY

To assure that our currently enrolled students experience the strongest academic program possible, enrollment in online courses will be allowed according to the following guidelines:

- ***The King's Academy Online*** courses may be taken only with the approval of the Administration.
- Students must have a 3.0 GPA or better to enroll in an online course from ***The King's Academy Online***, unless the course is being taken for remediation purposes or in Summer School.
- Students may not take an online course during the regular school day schedule without special permission from the Administration. ***The King's Academy Online*** courses will be taken *in addition* to a regular, full schedule. All schedule slots must be filled with on-campus classes.
- Students will be allowed to enroll in no more than two ***The King's Academy Online*** course credits per school year.

## TUITION & FEES

Students will be charged \$800 for one ***The King's Academy Online*** semester course, or \$1500 for each full-year course. Fees for courses may vary, depending on the required texts and materials. Additional charges may be assessed for dual enrollment courses. All charges will be calculated into the tuition bill.

## ***The King's Academy Online*** COURSES AND GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

School policy stipulates that all courses required for graduation must be successfully completed at The King's Academy. Students may take courses required for graduation from ***The King's Academy Online***, with the following restrictions:

**Mathematics:** A student must successfully complete 5 credits of Mathematics (8<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grades ) to qualify for graduation from The King's Academy. He or she may take only one of the required mathematics courses from ***The King's Academy Online***: Algebra I, Geometry and Algebra II, Honors Statistics, AP Statistics, Trigonometry/Calculus, AP Calculus AB, AP Calculus BC.

Additional Mathematics courses may be taken from ***The King's Academy Online***.

**History/Social Studies:** A student must successfully complete 4 credits of History/Social Studies to qualify for graduation from The King's Academy. He or she may take only one of the required History/Social Studies courses from ***The King's***

**Academy Online** with the exception of *Old Testament World History*, which must be taken on campus: World History, AP World History, U.S. History, AP U.S. History, Economics, AP Macroeconomics, American Government, Honors European History.

Additional History and Social Studies courses may be taken from ***The King's Academy Online***.

**Science:** Student must successfully complete 4 credits of Science, which must include a full year of Biology and a full year of Chemistry, to qualify for graduation from The King's Academy. Students may take only one of the required science courses from ***The King's Academy Online***: Biology, AP Biology, Chemistry, AP Chemistry, Marine Science, Earth-Space Science, or Physics. Additional Science courses may be taken from ***The King's Academy Online***.

**English:** Student must successfully complete 4 credits of English to qualify for graduation from The King's Academy. Four English courses must be completed on campus. Courses from ***The King's Academy Online*** will not satisfy this requirement.

Additional English courses may be taken from ***The King's Academy Online***.

**Foreign Languages:** A students must successfully complete 2 credits (levels I and II) of a foreign language to qualify for graduation from The King's Academy. Students may satisfy this requirement by taking two years of a foreign language (levels I and II) from ***The King's Academy Online***.

A student may pursue additional levels or languages from ***The King's Academy Online***.

**Bible:** Students must successfully complete the following courses, accumulating 2.5 credits of Bible to qualify for graduation from The King's Academy: Old Testament History, Introduction to the Bible, Biblical Philosophy and World cultures, and Faith & Cultures. Students must take the required Bible courses on campus.

A student may pursue additional Bible course from ***The King's Academy Online***.

**Fine Arts, Physical Education & Electives:** A student must successfully complete 1 credit of Fine Arts and 1 credit of Physical Education to qualify for graduation from The King's Academy. These two requirements may be satisfied through ***The King's Academy Online*** courses.

Student may pursue additional Electives from ***The King's Academy Online***.

## Additional Policies:

- Courses taken from ***The King's Academy Online*** will be added to a student's transcript, and the grade received will be calculated into the student's GPA.
- All courses attempted from ***The King's Academy Online*** will be noted on a student's transcript. Withdrawing from a ***The King's Academy Online*** course before its completion will result in a WP (Withdrawn Passing) or a WF (Withdrawn Failing) notation on the student's transcript.
- Students enrolled in a ***The King's Academy Online*** course must complete the requirements of that course within the start and end dates set by the Administration, unless permission is granted to do so. Failure to do so will be noted as a "WF" or "WP" on the student's transcript, depending on the grade he or she has attained in that course.
