

STUDENTS NOT CURRENTLY ENROLLED AT THE KING'S ACADEMY

STUDENTS ENROLLING IN 3 OR MORE CREDIT HOURS (Full time)

Admission to *The King's Academy Online* for students taking 3 credit hours or more requires a current Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.0 and two satisfactory teacher recommendations. Students who enroll full time may set the goal of graduating and receiving a diploma from The King's Academy's online program.

TUITION & FEES

Students not currently enrolled at The King's Academy will pay tuition of \$900 per semester course and \$1600 for each full-year course. Payment for full-time students (six classes or more) may be made monthly through arrangement with the Business Office. Fees for courses may vary, depending on the required texts and materials, and additional fees may be required for dual enrollment classes.

To apply, send the following to the Admissions Office:

- 1) A completed *The King's Academy Online* application
- 2) Report cards from the current school year and the final report cards from the two previous school years
- 3) Two completed teacher recommendation forms
- 4) The application fee of \$100.
